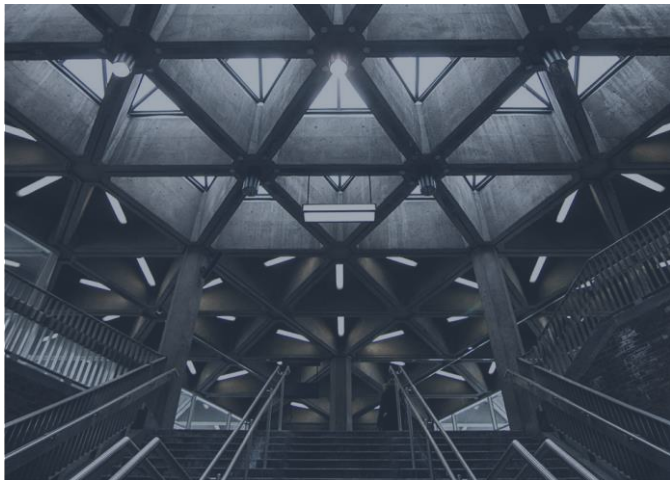


YOUR ONLY A STEP AWAY FROM BECOMING A LICENSED AND CERTIFIED CHAPLAIN
